The Judge will explain each class decision.

Class Fee: \$30.00 per horse – ride all classes you want. This includes a \$10 fee for show insurance.

Stall Fee: \$20.00 per stall – only 10 stalls available, contact: Katja for stall reservation at: 352 - 558 - 4635

Location: Seminole Wind Farms. Take HWY 27 N. towards Williston. Make a right onto Hwy 316. Farm is one mile on the left.

Note: Classes with fewer than three entries may be combined with other classes, so arrive early.

High Point awards will be given for each class. There will be six (6) placements. The points will range from 6 points to 1 point.

High Point awards will go to the horse entered in each class. In the professional class, the High Point will go to the trainer. In Equitation, the High Point will go to the rider.

Four horses will place in Championship classes and points will not count for High Point awards. The fun classes will not have High Point awards.

Rules:

- 1. Children under 13 must wear helmets.**
- 2. No youth under 18 may ride a stallion.**
- 3. You must sign a release if you plan to ride on the premises, even if you do not show.**
- 4. No dogs allowed on premises.**
- 5. No alcohol allowed.**
- 6. All horses must have a negative Coggins (bring a copy) and health papers if you are coming from out of state.**

Food and drinks may be purchased at the show, or bring your own. Other equine vendors will be invited.

Points awarded at the July 18 th show will be added to those accrued during the prior 2009 shows.
